Vancouver, BC: If you are an adult living with epilepsy in BC and you have ever wanted to grade the adult epilepsy system in BC, now is your chance!

The *Your Voice Matters: Adult Epilepsy System Report Card* survey allows adults living with epilepsy in BC to have a voice and share their experiences by assigning a report card grade to BC's adult epilepsy system.

Kim Davidson, CEO & Executive Director of the BC Epilepsy Society, has stated that "Adults living with epilepsy in BC have not had a voice regarding data collection in the adult epilepsy health care crisis. Those days are over!"

Kim added that "**By participating in our survey, you are holding this government accountable and responsible for funding decisions going forward. Our doctors and patients have a right to the same resources, standard of care, and epilepsy programs as seen in other parts of Canada. This survey is your voice for change! Your participation has never mattered more than it does now!**"
